Two core elements:

Information Literacy and Critical Analysis:

HPQ & EPQ:

The Higher Project Qualification (HPQ) and the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) are two cornerstone projects designed to develop students' research skills, critical thinking, and independent learning. These qualifications provide students with the opportunity to explore topics of personal interest in depth, equipping them with the tools they need to succeed in higher education and beyond.

Four Domains:

IGCSE/A-Level: provide globally recognised IGCSE and A-Level courses, preparing students to meet the rigorous requirements of top universities worldwide.

Career Exploration & University Readiness:

This programme empowers students to make thoughtful, informed decisions about their future, ensuring they pursue careers that are not only rewarding but also aligned with their strengths and aspirations.

Co-curricular Activities:

Students engage in a wide range of co-curricular activities, including extensive academics, sports, arts, and business, to explore their passions and develop leadership and teamwork skills.
